


Divi – copying sections, rows, or modules between pages

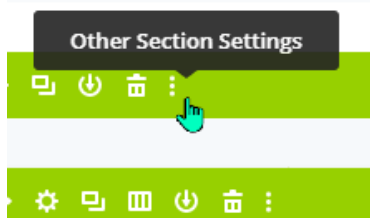
Sometimes there's a section, row, or module on one page that you really want to see on another and you don't want to build it from scratch.

Unfortunately the little “copy” / “duplicate” double squares on a module  only duplicates a section/row/module onto the SAME page, and doesn't make it available to move to a different page on your site.

But there is another tool – **Save to Library!** Here's how to use it:

Note: I generally find this much easier to do on the back side of the Divi Builder because you can more easily see where all the boxes line up.

There are three little dots in the section/row/module header.



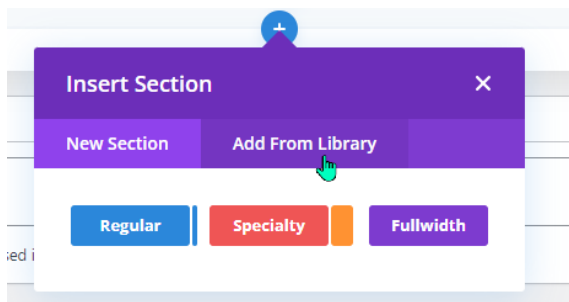
when you click on that you get this to pop up, and select "Save to Library."



Give it a name you can remember.

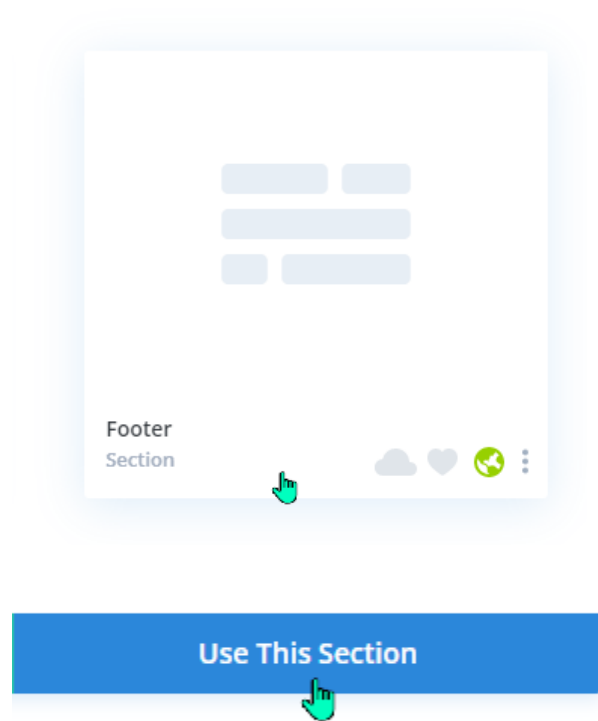
Then go to where you want to add it on the target page.

Click the circle+ for the same type of area (section/row/header) and "Add from Library"

Find the one you just saved and click "use this section."



And, *voila!*, the section/row/module from your other page has appeared on your new page.
